



Cub Scout Pack 747 - Popcorn Sale

Scouts and their families

Popcorn sales are the number one way that Cub Scouts earn funds to pay for our programs held during the course of the year. There are also great prizes that can be earned for selling different amounts of popcorn.

Popcorn pays for:

- 10% of the total of popcorn sales goes directly to pay for the scout's summer camp
- 20% of the total of popcorn sales returns to the cub scout pack (SRS scouting program)
 - We use this to pay for pizza at pack meetings
 - Food for camping
 - Den outings (Holliday Park, crafts, entrance fees where necessary)
 - Awards and trophies (raingutter regatta, pinewood derby)

The season for Popcorn sales is upon us. Scouts can begin to sell popcorn starting **Saturday, Sept 26**. To help us tally up all sales, we need all forms to be returned by **Monday, November 1**. We need to the orders to be returned along with the funds to pay for the popcorn order.

Suggestions for selling:

- Wear your cub scout uniform when selling popcorn
- Know your popcorn and what you like to eat
- Bring a parent or older sibling with you when selling door to door
- You can suggest that even if the person doesn't like popcorn, they can purchase popcorn that will be delivered to the troops overseas. (tax deductible too)

What you need to remember:

- Start selling on **Saturday, Sept 26**.
- Checks must be made out to **St. Richards Scouting**.
- All orders must be turned in to our pack on **Monday, November 1**.
- All money for the popcorn must be turned in with the order on **Monday, November 1**.
- Popcorn will be delivered to St. Richards on **Saturday, Dec 5**.
